Karam presented Ordinance 26-0-1 which clarifies reservation procedures, defines key terms, and establishes that facility use is exclusive to the approved reserving party unless otherwise authorized. Trustee Jurczyk made a motion that was seconded by Trustee Talbot to approve Ordinance 26-0-1: An Ordinance Regulating Room Reservations and use of Township Facilities.

Roll Call: Jurczyk-yes; Koob-absent; Andreae-yes; Talbot-yes; Karam-yes. Motion Carried.

**D. Resolution 26-R-1: A Resolution to Oppose Township Consolidation into County Government**

Karam presented Resolution 26-1 A Resolution to Oppose Township Consolidation into County Government which states the Township board's opposition to proposed state legislation that would consolidate township government into county government. Trustee Andreae made a motion that was seconded by Trustee Talbot to approve Resolution 26-R-1: A Resolution to Oppose Township Consolidation into County Government.
